BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR CONCENTRATE

BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR is an easily applied liquid that makes carpet ,soil and stain-resistant. Dust, dirt and grime find it hard to stick to treated carpet and tests repeatedly show that treated carpet looks cleaner than untreated carpet between cleans. BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR CONCENTRATE is simply diluted in water and spray applied either to freshly cleaned damp carpet or to clean dry carpet.

BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR is effective on all carpet fibres but is especially well-suited to nylon. It contains no flammable or odour causing solvents, and is stable to prolonged storage even in the diluted ready-to-use state

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Proper application is essential to good performance and customer satisfaction. It is particularly important though to follow the directions for carpet preparation and to make every effort to insure uniform spray coverage.

Preparation of carpet

- 1. Vacuum the carpet to remove all loose soil.
- 2. Remove spots by your preferred to professional method.
- 3. Thoroughly clean the carpet using the hot water (steam extraction) method. Not necessary for new carpet.

NOTE: Shampooing can leave detergent on the carpet which greatly accelerates resoiling and can reduce the performance of BROLLY® CARPET PROTECTOR. Therefore, when shampooing is required, it should be followed with hot water extraction to remove excess shampoo.

Preparation of spray mix

- 1. Measure the area to be treated to determine the amount of spray mix required.
- 2. Prepare the spray mix as follows, making sure to add the water to the concentrate.

For damp clean carpet

Mix 1 part BROLLY® CARPET PROTECTOR CONCENTRATE with 15 parts water. Apply to the carpet at the rate of 2lt of diluted spray mix for every 10 sq. metres of carpet to be treated.

For dry carpet

Mix 1 part BROLLY® CARPET PROTECTOR with 31 parts of water. Apply to the carpet at the rate of 4lt of diluted spray mix for every 10 sq. metres of carpet to be treated.



NOTE:

Use only the recommended level of BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR.

Excessive levels of BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR can deluster carpet.

Excessive levels of water can damage carpet backing and promote mildew and odour.

APPLICATION

- 1. Use a good quality clean sprayer eg a Solo. Plastic tanks are recommended to prevent rusting or staining. A 8004 Tee Jet Nozzle is recommended.
- 2. Hold the spray nozzle 30cm (12") to 45cm (18") from the carpet and apply half the prepared spray mix over the entire carpet area, spraying in one direction only. Then apply the other half over the entire carpet area again spraying in the opposite direction.
 - Be certain to maintain enough spray pressure to ensure a uniform spray pattern. If the pump tank is fitted with a pressure gauge, do not allow the pressure to drop below 30 psi.

NOTE:

It is extremely important to obtain uniform coverage. Uneven application may result in uneven soiling.

- 3. To obtain the best performance from BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR, work the product into the carpet immediately after spraying.
 - Use a pile brush on pile type constructions.
 - · Use a carpet rake for open shag constructions.
- 4. Allow the carpet to dry. The soil and stain protection of BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR will be fully effective as soon as the carpet is dry.

CLEAN UP

1. Rinse the tank, hose and spray nozzle thoroughly with fresh water after each use.

NOTE:

Failure to properly clean the spray equipment can lead to plugged nozzles and uneven application.

- 2. Use fresh water to clean up any accidentally spilled spray mix.
- 3. Wash hands thoroughly when finished.

RETREATMENT

BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR is a very durable finish. Most of the treatment remains even after extraction cleaning. Therefore, when retreating, use only one-half of an original treatment. Simply follow application directions, using one-half the recommended level of BROLLY CARPET PROTECTOR in the spray mix.
