LEATHER CLEANER

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Sonitron LEATHER CLEANER is a thick, off white emulsion, which can be spread easily over the surface of the leather giving good control and economy in the cleaning operation. It has a 3-way action:

CLEANS: A fast and effective cleaner.

CONDITIONS: Keeps the protective top coat supple to reduce the risk of cracking. **PROTECTS:** Leaves a protective film to reduce future soiling.

APPLICATIONS

The product is designed for maintaining upholstery leather in furniture such as leather lounges. It is particularly important to identify the type of leather for which the product is suitable.

Smooth finished pigmented leather

This leather is coloured and has a protective urethane topcoat. This gives a soft sheen appearance. This type of leather is used for most of the leather furniture produced, and Sonitron LEATHER CLEANER is suitable for maintaining this type.

Semi Aniline Leather

This leather has a very soft feel and a velvet like appearance. It is drum dyed with penetrating aniline dyes and has a very thin surface coating to assist in preventing soiling.

Great care needs to be taken when cleaning this type of leather. The LEATHER CLEANER can be used but a careful examination should be made to ensure the protective coating has not worn off in high wear areas. Also, a very careful pre-test is essential.

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Sonitron LEATHER CLEANER is suitable for maintaining the vast majority of leather furniture. The best way to prolong the life and appearance of leather furniture is regular cleaning. Perspiration and body oils together with environmental factors such as city smog or salt air, are all major causes of damage and should be removed regularly from the leather surface.



LEATHER CLEANER has been designed as a multi purpose product, which is simple, rapid and economical to use. It is equally suitable for the busy professional who has to clean a carpet and a leather lounge and get to the next job on time, or the "in house" maintenance officer in a busy hotel or motel.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Vacuum the upholstery to remove dust or any loose surface soil. Shake the bottle well before use. Pre-test in an inconspicuous area to ensure the product is suitable. Look for loss of colour, or gloss or darkening.

Inspect the furniture carefully for cracks or cuts or worn areas where the protective urethane coating may have worn off, or spots or stains which may be difficult to remove. Any imperfection where the bare leather is exposed may darken on treatment. If considered necessary advise the furniture owner before proceeding.

The LEATHER CLEANER is used undiluted. Apply to a clean piece of towelling and apply liberally over the leather. Use a soft brush to work the cleaner into the leather, then pick up the soil with clean towel. When the leather is clean, apply a second light coat of the cleaner followed by buffing with clean soft towelling.

To extend the life and retain the beauty of the leather, this procedure should really be carried out between 2 and 4 times per annum, depending on the rate of soiling.

SAFETY NOTES

LEATHER CLEANER is not classified as dangerous goods for transit purposes, but may cause an allergic skin reaction and is harmful to aquatic life. A Safety Data Sheet is available detailing first aid in case of accidental swallowing etc. Professionals handling detergents continually should always avoid skin contact as much as possible and avoid spilling into waterways.
